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I am writing a plug-in to send email notification to the admin for any profile change. It should be done in a week or two. I'll post here when it is.

Options will include being able to override the Joomla admin email address and some customization of what the message says. But I was not planning on any field selectability other than system and user-defined fields. System fields include the basics, such as email address, name, username, etc. User-defined fields are everything else. It is unfortunately not possible to have dynamic field selections in a plug-in admin panel. I'd have to write a component to do that, and I'm just not up to it right now (just finished a big one recently).

If you can think of any other features that might be useful, let me know.
