Medical Benefits, Dental Benefits, Vision Care (like the tab names above the fields in the screenshot below).


BTW – the labels are fields supplying page names to documents and webpages.

Since the name of the field (name of the page) can change, I want the field to be the label and not a language string.


This particular field (Restrict Pages) will allow the user to specify which pages are restricted by a username/password on their website.
